SNOW EMERGENCY

The City Manager has declared a snow emergency and snow removal operations along some of the major streets in Rock Island are being hampered by vehicles parked in violation of the snow route ordinance (Section 9-41 of the Rock Island Code of Ordinances). This ordinance states that in the event of a storm depositing two (2) inches or more of snow, parking is not allowed on marked snow routes until the snow has been removed.

Effective immediately, vehicles parked in violation of this ordinance will receive at \$25.00 parking ticket. Vehicles that remain in violation of this ordinance on Wednesday, January 28, 2004, will be impounded.

Beginning at 8:00 p.m., Tuesday, January 27, 2004, there will be no on-street parking allowed in the downtown business area (15th Street to 23rd Street, 1st Avenue to 5th Avenue) due to snow removal operations. There will be free parking in the City Lot D (20th Street at 3rd Avenue). Cars left on the street after 10:00 p.m. will be towed to the nearest unaffected street.
