PUBLIC WORKS DEPT. ANNOUNCES SPRING CLEAN-UP WEEK

Rock Island's [Public Works Department](#) will be out in full force during Spring Clean Up Week, April 26th through April 30th. This is **your chance to get rid of bulky items and other debris** that has accumulated through the winter months!

Please observe the following guidelines:

- Bulky items and refuse will be collected on your **regular collection day**.
- All items must be placed at their regular pick up site **by 7:00 a.m.**
- Containers should not be placed at pick-up site any earlier than noon the day prior to pick-up and should be removed by noon the day after pick-up.
- Choose **containers** carefully! All containers other than your normal weekly refuse containers will be taken.
- Containers should weigh no more than 50 lbs.
- **Boards and limbs** should be cut into 4½ feet sections, tied, and bundled.
- **Medical sharps** must be placed in puncture proof containers.
- The City of Rock Island will not pick up large appliances or tires. For more information regarding large appliance pick ups, contact 1-800-917-1969.
- Tires may be dropped off at the following locations **only on May 1st**:
 - 45th Street and 6th Avenue (just north of St. John's Church)
 - 2nd Street and 6th Avenue
