JOINT SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE STUDY

In 2003, the cities of Moline and Rock Island participated in a “Joint Regional Service Delivery Study” conducted by consultant Maximus, Inc. One area of the study considered the collection and disposal of solid waste. A joint committee of Public Works staff was created to further analyze the refuse collection and processing options to serve the needs of all Moline and Rock Island citizens.



The joint committee has completed its study and now recommends a comprehensive reorganization of the refuse services provided by Moline and Rock Island. This reorganization aims to achieve the following goals:

- Enhance the services provided to residential customers;
- Enhance the appearance of residential neighborhoods;
- Provide a safer work environment for refuse service workers; and
- Reduce overall refuse service costs
