## Citizen Police Academy Seeks Applicants

Applications are currently being accepted for participation in the 2005 Illinois Quad Cities [Citizen Police Academy](#). This eleven-week program sponsored by seven area law enforcement agencies is designed to provide the participant with basic information on how your police department operates.



Classes start January 5, 2005 and will be held every Wednesday from 6:30 to 9:30 P.M.

In addition to having the opportunity to fire a police issued handgun, tour the county jail, and participate in a mock trial, participants will learn about Patrol Tactics, Use of Force, Laws of Arrest, Communications, Juvenile Law, Criminal Investigations, S.W.A.T., K-9, Community Policing, Bike Patrol, Accident Investigation, and the Metropolitan Enforcement Group.
