Each newsletter is 16 to 24 pages long and features articles by and about Rock Island's neighborhoods and city activities that impact life in [neighborhoods](#). Workshops, grants and special programs are also covered.

Neighborhood Partners of Rock Island is a city-appointed board made up of various neighborhood associations, not-for-profit agencies, the school district and other organizations with neighborhood-based interests. Federal [Community Development Block Grant](#) funds allocated to Neighborhood Partners pays for the printing and mailing of the newsletter.
