Vendors invited to Participate in King Center Event.

The Martin Luther King Community Center and the Metropolitan Youth Program have combined efforts to host the annual King Center Family Fun Day. An invitation is extended to all companies, businesses, and organizations interested in applying as a food or merchant vendor. Those seeking to display information booths about their organization are also welcome.

Your organization may apply to participate as volunteers, a vendor, and/or informational patron. The event will take place on **Saturday, August 6, 2005 from 10:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.** The first event for the day will be our annual parade which will feature Drill Teams from other cities that will compete in a showdown later in the day. The parade will kick-off at Frances Willard school located at 2503 - 9th Street at 10:30 a.m. and will conclude at the [King Center](#) at approximately 11:15 a.m. A variety of exciting events will be taking place throughout the day on the grounds of the Center, where all of the vending and information booths will be located.

The fee to participate in this event for each individual food booth, merchant booth, and others that are working to earn a profit is \$75.00. *This fee will cover the cost of electrical usage, permits, labor, and security.* We will supply electricity if needed, however, you must bring a heavy-duty extension cord for your organizations use. There is no fee for an informational booth. You will be responsible for all set-ups, tear down and clean up associated with your booth. The King Center will provide the clean up of the grounds.
