Armory Park Development Options Presented

The public is invited to attend a meeting on the proposed redevelopment of the Levee Parking Lot and Rock Island Armory. The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, September 13, 2005 6:30 p.m.** in City Council Chambers 1528 Third Avenue. Presentations will be made by Schreiber Anderson Associates (SAA) and Hendricks Development Group about both sites.



SAA has developed three [concept plans](#) for the area located between the Armory and Modern Woodmen of America's corporate headquarters (1st Avenue between 17th and 18th Streets) the Naturalized Edge, Water Wall and Oval Green options:

Each scheme will be explained and citizens will have the opportunity to select elements they prefer from each. A preference survey will be passed out at the meeting. SAA recognizes that elements of the three plans can be mixed and matched and are not mutually exclusive.

Hendricks will present information about the potential for reusing the Armory. This architecturally important City-owned building on the riverfront has been vacant for several years. Hendricks is exploring options for reusing the structure. The City is also interested in hearing your reaction to this opportunity.
