## **Citizen Police Academy Accepting Applications**

Applications are currently being accepted for participation in the 2006 Illinois Quad Cities Citizen Police Academy. This eleven-week program sponsored by seven area law enforcement agencies is designed to provide the participant with basic information on how your police department operates. Classes start January 4, 2006 and will be held every Wednesday from 6:30 to 9:30 P.M.



In addition to having the opportunity to shoot a police-issued handgun, tour the county jail, and participate in a mock trial, participants will learn about Patrol Tactics, Crash Investigation, Laws of Arrest, Communications, Juvenile Law, Criminal Investigations, S.W.A.T., Self Defense, K-9, Community Policing, Bike Patrol, Use of Force, Metropolitan Enforcement Group, Gangs, and Illinois Law Enforcement Alarm System.
