

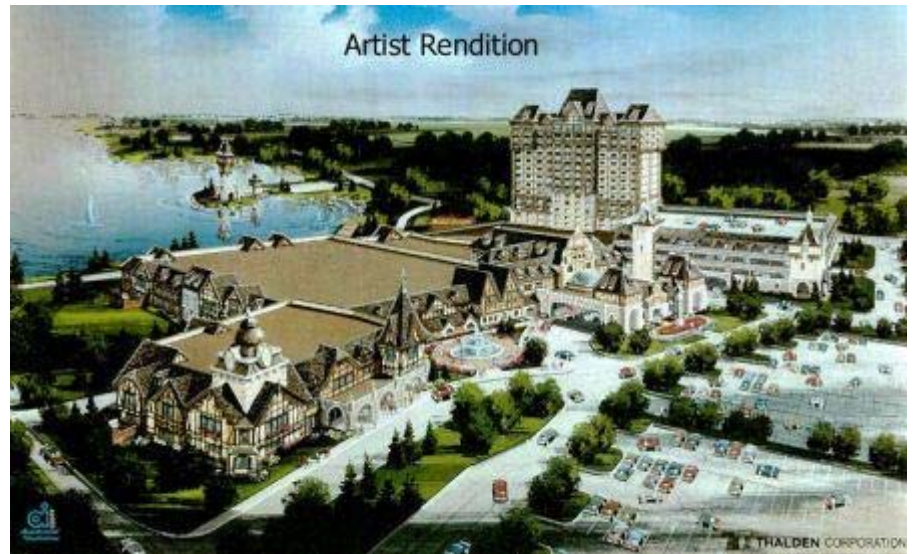

REVISED PLANS ANNOUNCED FOR \$125 MILLION CASINO PROJECT

Officials of Jumer's Casino Rock Island announced revised plans to construct its proposed new casino. Now, the project will open as a fully operational casino and hotel. Construction of a casino, hotel, four restaurants, theatre space, parking deck and surface parking will happen simultaneously instead of in two phases.



The \$125 million project will include a 40,000 square foot casino single floor layout with 1,100 slot machines and 24 table games. The project also includes a 200-room hotel, four restaurants, 450-space parking structure, 12,000 square foot theatre, and conference and banquet space for 1,100 patrons. The site is 118 acres, with 38 acres being used for the casino resort development.

The project still must receive Illinois Gaming Board approval before construction can begin. The new location will have premium access and visibility, located at the intersection of Interstate 280 and Highway 92.

The revision to its original plan developed because of favorable market conditions and the commitment of the Jumer organization to this project and the community.

Hopefully construction will begin in Summer 2006.
