11TH STREET CAR SHOW

The Sixth Annual [11th Street Car Show](#) is set for Saturday, September 16, 2006, 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Watch Tower Plaza, 3800 11th Street. This event is sponsored by the 11th Street / 31st Avenue Business Association. The Show is the Association's major fundraiser and supports our efforts to improve the 11th Street area as a place to work, shop and live.

Once again, there will be a wide variety of vehicles, from classic Chevys and Fords to custom motorcycles, trucks and more recent Neons and PT Cruisers. Take a look at the cars,

trucks, dune buggies and motorcycles. There will be three classes – cars, trucks and motorcycles – with trophies awarded to the top three in each class, plus the People's Choice and the Mayor's Choice.

In addition to the vehicles, you'll find hot dogs, brats, popcorn, music, voter registration, Kids ID from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., arts and crafts, vendors and other displays. 3D Sound will play music from the '50s up through current tunes. The [Rock Island Fire Department](#) will have a truck on display and the [Police Department's K-9 Unit](#) will put on a demonstration at 1 p.m.

If you want to enter a vehicle in the Show, early registration (by September 13th) is \$12 or \$15 the day of the show.

Admission is free for spectators.

Vehicle registration is from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. Judging is from 11 a.m. - 1 p.m. for entrants to select their top three and the public to vote on the People's Choice. Awards will be presented at 1:30 p.m. and the event will conclude by 2 p.m.
