DOWNTOWN PARKING CHANGES

The City of Rock Island is pleased to announce changes to the Downtown Parking System. The changes are being made to balance the parking system demands, foster a greater utilization of city parking facilities, and assist with downtown marketing.

The Downtown Parking Changes will go into effect on November 1, 2006.

The new Downtown Parking System will:

- Retain the "Brown Zones" (2 hour free, customer parking) and short-term (30 minute) parking meters.
- Retain long-term (10 hour) parking meters in the Parking Ramp and Lot C to provide convenient spaces for visitors who need to park for more than 2 hours.
- Allow UNLIMITED, FREE PARKING on a first come first served basis in all on-street spaces currently used for "Green Zone" parking.
- A new Downtown parking permit (\$20/month) has been created that authorizes parking in unreserved, unmetered spaces in the Ramp, Lot C, Lot D, and Lot E on a first come first served basis.
- A new Reserved parking permit (\$50/month) that includes an initial set up fee of \$50 has been created to allow a person to reserve their own parking space.
