Rock Island Seeking Input on the 2008-2013 Consolidated Plan and 2008-2009 Annual Action Plan

The City of Rock Island has completed its draft of the 2008-2013 Consolidated Plan and One Year Action Plan. Copies are available for your review on the 2nd floor of City Hall, at the Martin Luther King Center, on the city website at www.rigov.org under "Important Links" and at the Rock Island Public Library located at 401 19th Street.

The Consolidated Plan sets forth the City's priority community development objectives over the next five years. The One Year Action Plan, contained within the Consolidated Plan, identifies the federal, state, and local resources expected to be available to the City of Rock Island and non-profit organizations providing services to the City's citizens during FY 2008-2009 to address these priorities. The Action Plan also serves as the City's annual funding application for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.

The City welcomes your review and comments regarding all components of the Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan. A public hearing has been scheduled for **Tuesday, January 29, 2008 at 5:30 p.m.** in the City Council Chambers, 3rd Floor of City Hall, 1528 3rd Avenue, Rock Island, Illinois 61201. You may provide your comments during this hearing; you may also provide written comments in the form of a letter or comments over the phone. Comments will be accepted through February 8th at 5:00 p.m.
