Police Officer Testing Date has Changed and Application Deadline Extended

The City of Rock Island has extended the application deadline for the Police Officer position and has changed the testing date. [Police Officer application](#) deadline has been extended to May 2, 2008.



The physical agility test has been changed from April 26, 2008 to May 10, 2008. The physical agility test will be held at the PepsiCo Recreation Center, 1025 - 30th Street, Rock Island, Illinois between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. A valid driver's license must be presented the day of the agility test. The written test has also been rescheduled from April 26, 2008 to May 10, 2008 at Rock Island High School upon successfully completing the physical agility test. Applicants must have completed a [Police Officer application](#) by May 2, 2008 to be eligible to take the agility test.

This position requires knowledge, skill and mental development equivalent to four (4) years of high school plus the ability to successfully pass a physical agility test, written and oral examination, background investigation, drug testing, psychological exam, and medical examination. Candidates must have a valid driver's license and be 21 years of age upon appointment. Selected candidates must meet the residency requirement, which requires the employee to live in Illinois no more than fifteen (15) miles from the center of Rock Island, within 6 months after completing the one (1) year probation period.

Applications will be accepted through May 2, 2008.
