## Help Keep Rock Island Beautiful Flower Planting

Help Keep Rock Island Beautiful by volunteering plant flowers along the Bike Path at the Mississippi River and Downtown on Saturday, May 17<sup>th</sup> from 8 a.m. – 12 p.m. Please meet at 20th Street and 1st Avenue in the City parking lot.



**What exactly is this?** A volunteer-based flower planting along the Rock Island bike path next to the Mississippi River and in downtown planters. Hosted by Keep Rock Island Beautiful on Saturday, May 17<sup>th</sup> from 8am – 12pm in Rock Island , IL.

**What will I be doing?** Volunteers will place mulch and fertilizer and plant flowers along our scenic riverfront bike path. All volunteers will be asked to meet at the registration table at the parking lot on the northeast corner of 20<sup>th</sup> Street and 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. in Rock Island. You will then be directed to a nearby site where you will help plant flowers.

**What do I need to bring?** You don't need to bring anything beside yourselves! But remember to dress appropriately (long pants and a t-shirt). Also, wear shoes that can get wet or muddy. We will provide you with gloves and bottled water.
