**What exactly is this?** A volunteer-based cleanup along the Rock Island bike path next to the Mississippi River. Hosted by Keep Rock Island Beautiful on Saturday, May 31<sup>st</sup> from 8 a.m. – 12 p.m. in Rock Island, IL.

**What will I be doing?** Volunteers will pick up litter along our scenic riverfront bike path. All volunteers will be asked to meet for registration table at the parking lot on 20<sup>th</sup> Street and 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. in R.I. You will then be directed to a nearby site where you will help remove the garbage that is polluting your bike path, waterways and your environment.

**What do I need to bring?** You don't need to bring anything beside yourselves! But remember to dress appropriately (long pants and a t-shirt). Also, wear shoes that can get wet and muddy. We will provide you with gloves, trash bags and bottled water.
