Sunset Marina Seeks Boaters' Advisory Committee Members

Sunset Marina is seeking leaseholders that would be interested in serving on the Boaters' Advisory Committee as a dock representative. The 700, 800 and 900 Docks are currently not represented. The terms for the representatives for 100 and 300 Docks will expire on June 1. There is also an opening for an at-large representative.

The Sunset Marina Boaters' Advisory Committee (BAC) consists of eleven members that are appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council. Nine of the members are Sunset Marina leaseholders and no more than two members may be from the same dock series. The other two members are residents of Rock Island and represent the general public. All members are appointed for three years. The BAC serves as a method of communication between the boat owners and marina management and in an advisory capacity with the City.

The Boaters' Advisory Committee meets on the third Thursday of each month. The [minutes](#) of the meetings are posted in the marina office as well as on City's [website](#).
