

City of Rock Island Launches Online Employment Applications

The City of Rock Island is introducing a new Online Application Process for City Employment starting Monday, August 11, 2008. All job applications for City employment must now be submitted online on the City's web site. Job applicants should go to www.rigov.org and click on "employment" to get started. Job applicants must have an email address in order to apply.

With the new Online Application Process job applicants can fill out an application on the City's web site and attach any supporting documents electronically. Applicants can then apply for a current job opening or save their application and supporting documents to use for a future position.

This new system also allows applicants to view all job descriptions and salary ranges for the City of Rock Island positions. Applicants can select the positions they are interested in and receive an email notification when those jobs are posted.

Two public computer stations are available for job applicants to complete online applications at City Hall, 1528 Third Ave., near the Personnel Office downstairs. Public internet access will not be available at these stations. All branches of the Rock Island Public Library have computers and internet access available to the public that can be used to fill out online applications.
