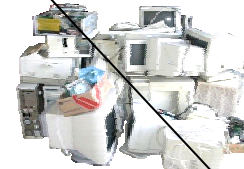

Contact Rock Island County Waste Management Agency (RICWMA) at 1-800-917-1969 to dispose of refrigerators, stoves, water heaters, freezers, air conditioners, dishwashers, furnaces, etc.

Rock Island County residents may contact the Scott County Household Hazardous Waste Collection facility at 563-381-1300 to schedule a drop off time to dispose of electronics and household hazardous waste. Acceptable household hazardous waste includes: drain openers, oven cleaners, spot removers, paint removers, stains and varnishes, epoxies and adhesives, weed killers, and insecticides.
